# **BLACKBOARD- Adaptive Release**

Faculty can control the release of content items to their students on a rule or set of rules they create. They can control what content is available to which students. And under what conditions, the students are allowed to see it.

#### **CONTENT ITEMS**

Content Items are anything ranging from:

- Item or File
- Audio, Image, Video or Web Link
- Assessment Items Tests, Survey's and Assignments

#### TYPES OF ADAPTIVE RELEASE

There are two types of Adaptive Release – Basic & Advanced

### **BASIC ADAPTIVE RELEASE**

- Add one rule for a single piece of content
- And inside of that rule, it can have multiple criteria

#### ADVANCED ADAPTIVE RELEASE

- Can add multiple rules to a single piece of content
- The content is visible to a student if any of the rules are met
- Inside each of those rules, you can have multiple criteria

## **RULE CRITERIA**

### Rules can be based on...

- Criteria related to Date & Time
- Individual Names &/or Groups (example, if you had content information that you'd like to share with Group 2 that is working a certain topic, you can post that and Adaptive Release it to only go to Group 2.)
- Review Status of another item in the course (*if students have done the reading that you assigned under lesson plan 1, then they are able to go on and see and do the quiz.*)
- Assessment Scores or Attempts (so if the student successfully completes quiz number 1 and they obtained a mark of 60% or higher, quiz 2 or extra information may then show for them so they can continue on in the course.)
